> **TRUE OR FALSE?** Now that you are 18, you are done with check-ups. **ANSWER:** False. Even if you are in great health, you will need at least yearly check-ups. For many young people, medical care is about prevention. Getting the right preventive care can keep you healthy and teach you how to avoid illness and disease. If you have asthma, diabetes or other chronic health conditions, your primary care provider may want to see you more often than yearly.
